Bob Block, who is a member of the Oregon Area Historical Society will give a presentation on prisoners of war camps in Wisconsin. Most people are unaware that Wisconsin had POW (Prisoners of War) camps during WWII and are surprised to learn that there were 39 of them having a total of approximately 20,000 POWs. This presentation will give an overview of US POWs camps and Wisconsin POW camps. This presentation tells interesting stories of those who may have lived in a community that had a POW camp, those who worked side by side with POWs and those who were once prisoners in a POW camp.
